Dear Staff and School Community:

We would like to inform you that we have recently received information of a positive COVID-19 case at MCOB Elementary School and a positive case at Villa Oasis. *Students and Staff that had close contact with the confirmed cases have been contacted by school personnel, if you are not contacted you are not determined to have been a close contact.*

Students and staff members that are considered close contacts must quarantine following CDC guidance. Shortening the quarantine period requires a negative COVID-19 test. Specific information on quarantine will be shared with those that are considered close contacts.

#### **How You Can Help**

Be proactive about reducing the number of interactions that students and staff have with one another by practicing physical distancing when possible (staying at least 6 feet apart) to limit the spread of the coronavirus. Important public health prevention messages include:

- **Stay home when you are sick.** Anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID 19 should remain at home in isolation for a minimum of 10 days plus at least 24 hours after the resolution of fever (without fever-reducing medication) and improvement in other symptoms.
- **Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.**
- **Cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue, and then dispose of the tissue and clean your hands immediately.**
- **Limit close contact with people who are sick, and avoid sharing food, drinks, or utensils.**
- **Wear a mask or face covering**

#### **Public Health Actions**

All confirmed cases should be isolated and close contacts quarantined. Close contact means being a household member, intimate contact, or caregiver of a confirmed or suspected COVID-19 case; within 6 feet of the confirmed or suspected COVID-19 case for more than 15 minutes.

Please note that all information, including the name(s) of ill persons, shared regarding any Public Health investigation is confidential to protect patient privacy.
