Vaccines provided this year: Immunizations other than Influenza (FLU) are available in limited supply.

<u>Influenza</u> (FLU) <u>Tdap</u> Tetanus/Diphtheria and Acellular Pertussis(whooping cough) <u>Prevnar 13 (Once in lifetime)</u> MMR (Measles, Mumps and Rubella) <u>Pneumovax 23 (2 or more in lifetime)</u>

Payment: No cost to employees/dependents covered under ASBAIT Medical plans and others below.

Insurance ID is required please bring to clinic

- Flu Shot vendor will also accept: Medicare (Flu/Pneumonia only), United Healthcare & BCBS
- Claim filed for member. Claim filing does not guarantee coverage
- No Insurance? No problem. Cash Price: Flu \$50 Quadrivalent, Tdap \$85, MMR \$115, Pneumovax 23 \$150,
 Prevnar 13 \$245

Why are flu shots important? 2018-2019 stats

- 670,000 people were hospitalized with flurelated complications
- 5-10% of those hospitalized = children <5 yrs.
- Flu related deaths:
 - \circ 36,000 61,200 from the flu complications
 - o 2017-18 172 were children 80% unvaccinated (final 18-19 stats unavailable)

Who should receive a flu shot?

- Everyone 6 months or older
- People at high risk for serious flu complications
- This includes young children, pregnant women
- Those with chronic medical conditions
- Anyone who wants protection against the flu
- Those caring for immunocompromised persons
